Please note that the following motions have been made by council in the past in order to support the Congr s Mondial acadien 2024.

**Motion made July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 at Special Council Meeting:**

2024 Congr s mondial acadien Bid Funding

It is moved by Guy Surette and seconded by Danny Muise to approve the submission of a bid for the 2024 Congr s mondial acadien with the Municipality of Clare and commit \$15,000 for the development of the bid and the bid fee.

*Motion Carried (6 in favour, 0 against)*

*Note: Actual expenses to March 31, 2019 amounted to \$4,134.*

**Motion made January 8, 2019 at Regular Council Meeting:**

CMA 2024-Request for funding

The organizing committee for the Congr s Mondiale 2024 has been working hard on the application to host the event in Clare-Argyle, or #Clargyle as they named it. As part of the application, one of the requirements is a commitment from the host municipal units to fund their portion of the event.

It is moved by Lucien LeBlanc and seconded by Glenn Diggdon to support the organizing committee in its bid to host the 2024 CMA and that the Municipality commit up to \$250,000 to that aim.

*Motion Carried (7 in favour, 0 against)*

*Note: The budget assumed Clare and Argyle would be the only municipal contributors. This will not be the case. Any amount received from neighboring municipal units should reduce our proportion of cost.*
