Subject: Windjammer Memorial Park Committee – Tax Exemption Request

Windjammer Memorial Park appealed to have their assessment reduced or eliminated through their councilor Kathy Bourque on May 21, 2019. Windjammer Park Committee Fund is a Non-Profit Organization registered with the Registry of Joint Stocks in Nova Scotia. Their goal is to build a memorial park in memory of the four children who perished in the Pubnico fire in January 2018.

The total Property Tax Invoice for 2019/2020 is \$139.20 however the Area Rate is not eligible to be exempt as per By-Law 28, so the total request for exemption will be the residential property amount of \$130.80.

Proposed Motion:

Council approve Tax Exemption Status for the Windjammer Memorial Park Committee which will also include a tax adjustment in the amount of \$130.80 in order to write off the 2019-2020 tax assessment bill.
